Tree Fruit Orchard Tour

High-Efficiency Tree Architecture and Harvest Aids for Cherries, Pears, and Apples

This tour will explore the use of harvest aids and mechanization for improving efficiency and reducing labor costs in tree fruit production. Researchers from Washington State University will share results of their work with harvest-assist machines and their effects on, productivity, efficiency, and bruising. Researchers and growers will discuss lessons learned from trellis designs and spacing that facilitate mechanization and maximize efficiency.
